The cadets participated in various activities and competitions.

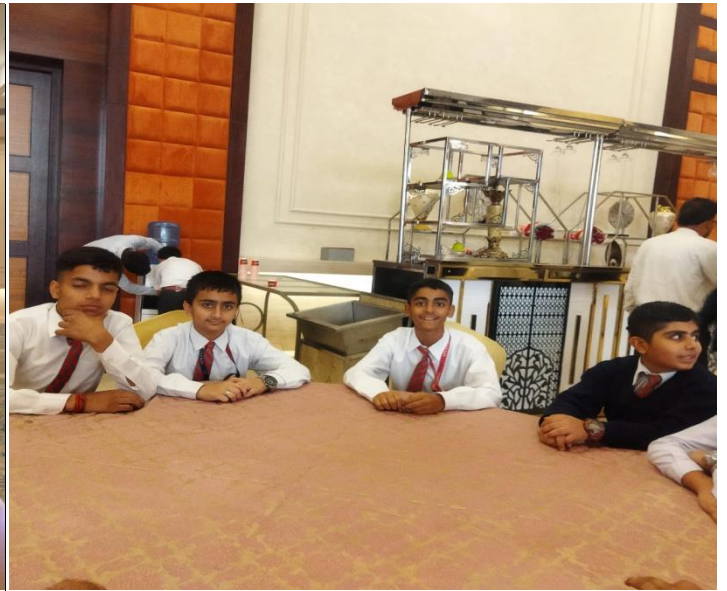
